ABOUT ICE BOWL IN KANSAS CITY

The KC Ice Bowl is more about friends, fun, and charity than pure competition. A change this year is that you can play on Saturday. (See above.) The instructions below apply to Sunday only.

1. Register at the shelter. Get your scorecard, disc, and mini set. Purchase clothing, other discs, mulligans, and CTP tickets.

2. Form a group of no more than 6 people. We can also find a group for you as needed. Play 18 holes on **EITHER COURSE**. All play needs to begin no later than 10:00 a.m.

3. When done, turn in your scorecard. Please let the TD know if **YOU ARE NOT PLAYING THE SECOND ROUND**, have some lunch, participate in the CTP contest, and play some mini golf.

4. Players will be ranked by their scores from the first round (or Sat. best round), which means you'll be very closely matched with the others on your card. You'll be told which nine holes you'll play. The player on each card with the best total score wins a DX disc. The person with the very best score is the Ice Bowl Champion and gets to keep the traveling trophy for one year.
